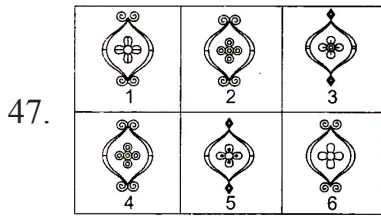
**Direction (Q:Nos 40-44): Which of the answer figure is exactly the mirror image of the given figure , when the mirror is placed on the line AB ?**





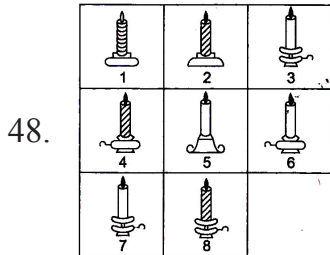

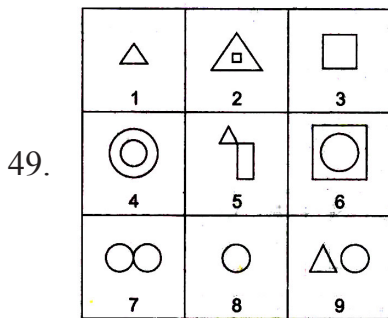

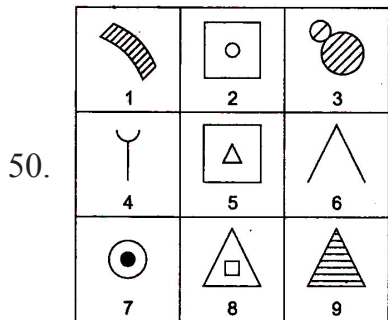
